Ten years ago, on May 1st, 1994, Ayrton Senna crashed to his death at Imola. For all those who still worship the great Brazilian and have no wish to forget him, I have created, with the help of my photos, this perpetual calendar as a permanent reminder of the career of this uniquely talented race driver and extraordinary human being. The important dates, recalling Ayrton Senna's pole positions and race victories, are identified on the appropriate days, and the calendar, which begins on May 1st, 2004, is valid for each subsequent year.

Vor zehn Jahren, am 1. Mai 1994, verunglückte Ayrton Senna in Imola tödlich. Für alle, die den großen Brasilianer noch heute verehren und nicht vergessen wollen, habe ich mit meinen besten Aufnahmen diesen „ewigen“ Kalender geschaffen: ein bleibendes Zeugnis der Karriere des begnadeten Rennfahrers und außergewöhnlichen Menschen Ayrton Senna. Seine wichtigen Daten, seine Pole-Positions und Siege, sind an den entsprechenden Tagen vermerkt. Das Kalendarium beginnt am 1. Mai 2004 und gilt jedes Folgejahr neu.

Há dez anos, a 1º de Maio de 1994, Ayrton Senna teve um acidente mortal em Imola. Para todos os que ainda veneram o grande piloto e não o podem esquecer, eu criei, com a ajuda das minhas fotos, este calendário "eterno" como uma permanente lembrança da carreira deste piloto de talento único e deste extraordinário ser humano. As datas importantes, relembrando as pole-positions e as vitórias de Ayrton Senna estão identificadas nos respectivos dias, e o calendário, que começa a 1º de Maio de 2004, é válido para cada ano subsequente.

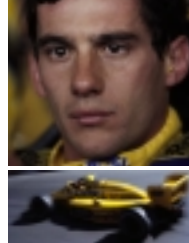
